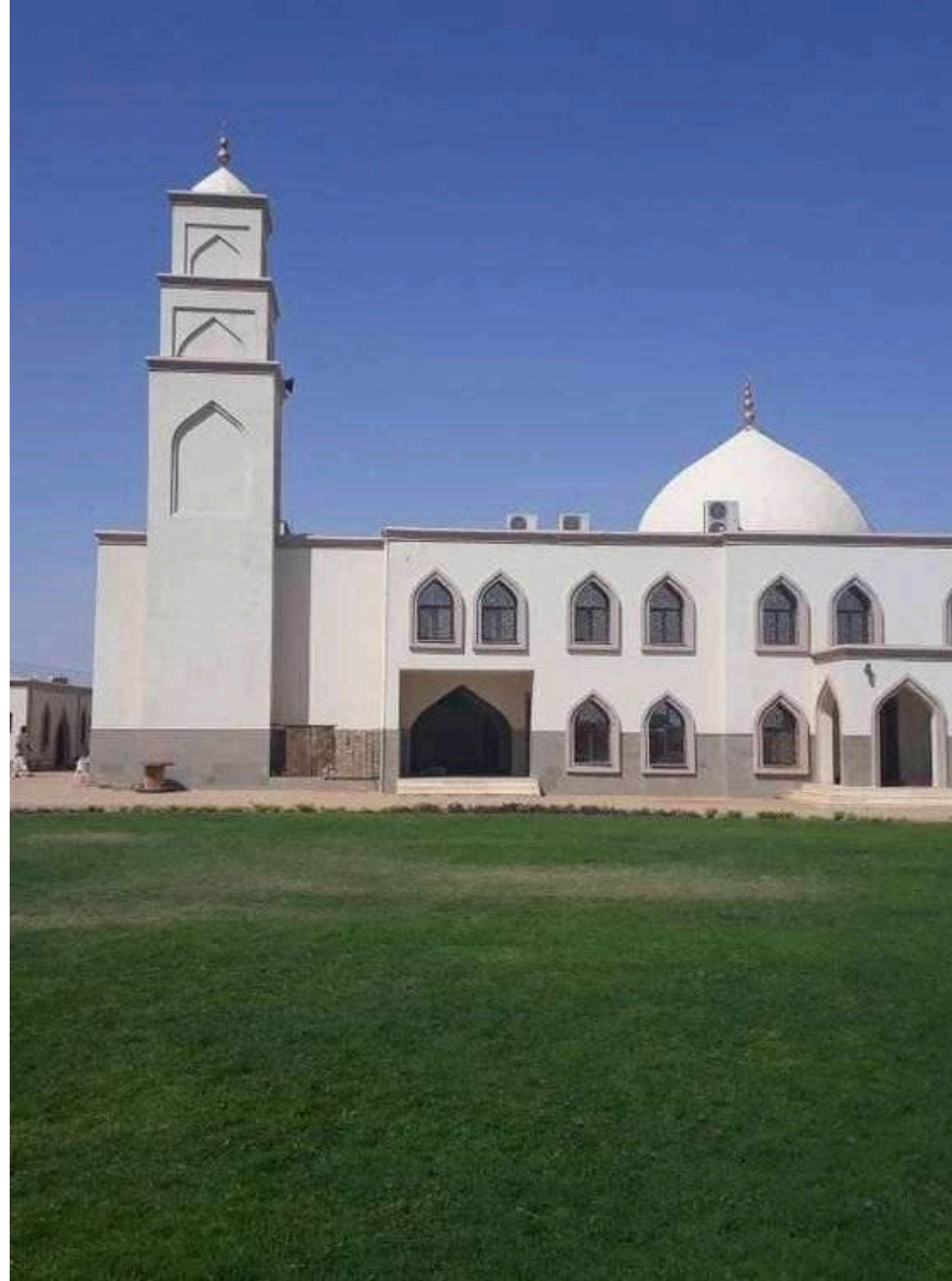

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1. Company Introduction

NVC Engineering & Contracting (New Vision for Construction) is a Sudanese general contracting firm established in 2013 and registered with the Ministry of Justice under partnership No. 16653. The company specialises in reinforced-concrete and steel structures, residential, commercial and religious complexes, industrial facilities, pavements, infrastructure and approved maintenance works.

Operations were suspended between April 2023 and 2026 as a direct result of the conflict in Khartoum. The company is now re-mobilising, with its legal identity, technical team and core plant preserved, and with its service lines extended to cover post-conflict structural assessment, rehabilitation and reconstruction works. Work has resumed on a commercial building at Al-Huda, Sherg Al-Nil in Khartoum, and a meeting-hall fit-out was completed during 2026 for the Sudanese Mineral Resources Company.

The company also owns a compressed-brick factory, which provides a measure of self-sufficiency in building materials.

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The company is actively working: a commercial building at Al-Huda — Sherg Al-Nil, Khartoum is live on site, and a completed delivery was made in 2026 for the Sudanese Mineral Resources Company (see page 04).

2. Where We Stand Today UPDATED

This page sets out the current position of the company. Site operations were suspended in April 2023 owing to the conflict in Khartoum. The company was not dissolved, and its registration, tax file and technical partnership remained in place throughout. Work resumed during 2026, with a project live on site and a completed delivery in the same year.

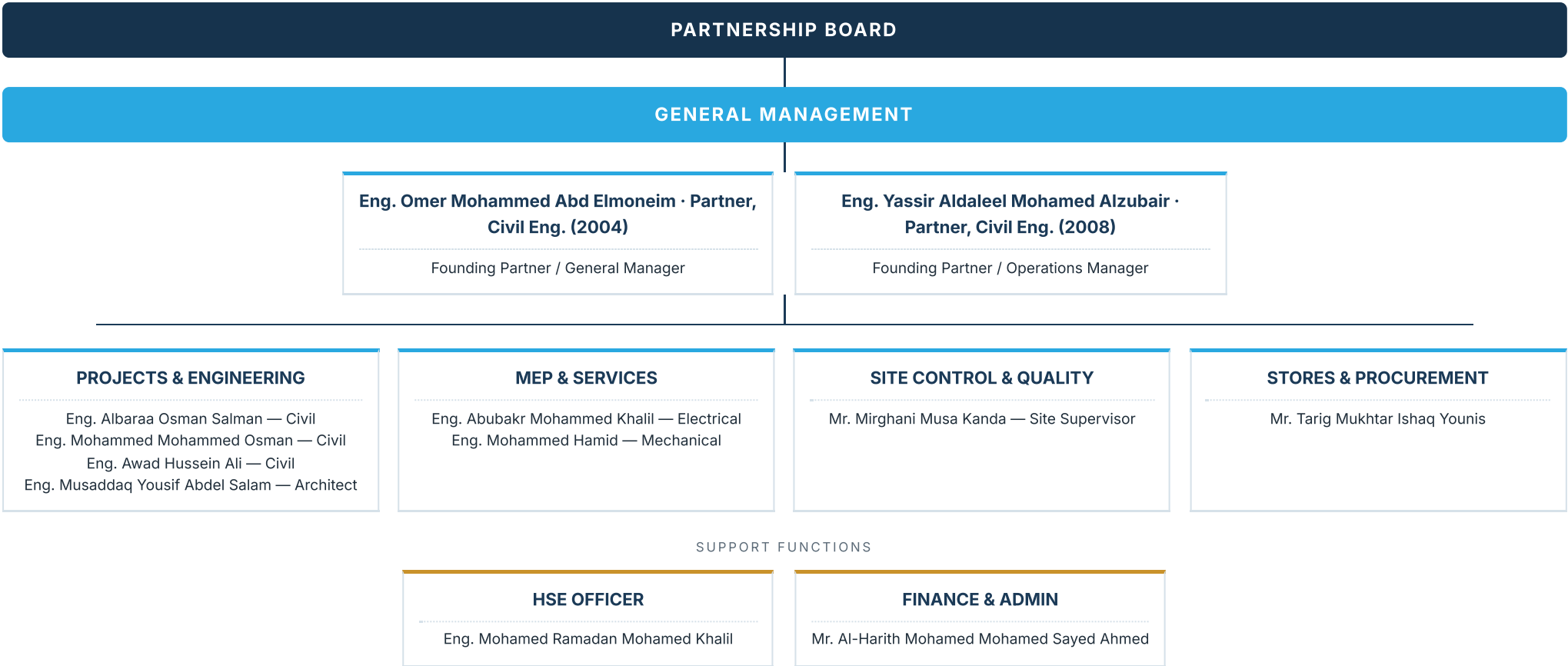

7. HSE Policy

NVC Engineering & Contracting is committed to every worker, engineer and visitor leaving site unharmed at the end of each day. Safety is treated as a precondition for starting work. No output and no cost saving is accepted at the expense of the safety of people, of the structure, or of the surrounding environment.

OUR COMMITMENTS

- Compliance with applicable Sudanese occupational safety and health law and with the safety requirements set out in client and donor contracts.
- Personal protective equipment (helmet, safety boots, gloves, harness for work at height) supplied to every worker without exception and at the company's cost.
- A written risk assessment prepared for every project before commencement and updated whenever the nature of the work changes.
- A short daily safety briefing (toolbox talk) held before work starts and recorded in the site log.
- Excavations, openings and scaffolds secured; no work at height without proper fixing and a safe means of access.
- A first-aid kit, a trained first-aider and a known medical evacuation route provided at every site.
- Employment of anyone under eighteen is prohibited, as is working under the influence of any substance.
- Construction and hazardous waste segregated and disposed of through approved contractors; discharge into watercourses is prohibited.

ORGANISATION & PERFORMANCE

- Company HSE officer: **Eng. Mohamed Ramadan Mohamed Khalil** — electromechanical engineer with civil-defence (basic and advanced) and site-hazard training — reports directly to General Management and is empowered to stop any unsafe work immediately.
- Every new worker receives a safety induction before entering site for the first time.
- Any incident or near miss is reported within 24 hours, investigated, and closed out with a documented corrective action.
- Performance is measured: hours worked without a lost-time injury (LTI), PPE compliance rate, and number of inspections carried out.
- The same safety obligations apply to sub-contractors and suppliers on site as to the company's own workforce.
- This policy is reviewed annually and for every project of a special nature.

8. Quality Policy & Delivery Method

QUALITY POLICY

- Works executed strictly to the approved drawings and specifications; any change is made only under a written variation order.
- Materials approved before delivery through samples and conformity documents (Material Approval Request).
- Concrete cube tests and reinforcement checks for every pour, with results retained in the project file.
- An inspection request submitted to the Consultant before every stage that will be covered: foundations, reinforcement, pouring.
- A complete project file handed over at completion: as-built drawings, material certificates, test results and warranties.
- The Consultant's snag list cleared before final handover.

DELIVERY METHOD

- 1 — Study of documents, site visit, and identification of risks and constraints before pricing.
- 2 — A detailed programme, resource plan and cash-flow forecast for each project.
- 3 — Site mobilisation: hoarding, offices and stores, water and power, project signboard.
- 4 — Phased execution, with inspection and approval of each stage before moving to the next.
- 5 — A weekly progress report with photographs and percentage completion, measured against the approved programme.
- 6 — Preliminary handover, then the maintenance and defects liability period, then final handover.

DEFECTS LIABILITY & WARRANTY

NVC provides a defects liability period on all executed works, counted from the date of preliminary handover, during which any defect attributable to workmanship or to materials supplied by the company is rectified at the company's own cost.

Defects liability period adopted by the company: **12 months from the date of preliminary handover**, or as stipulated in the contract.

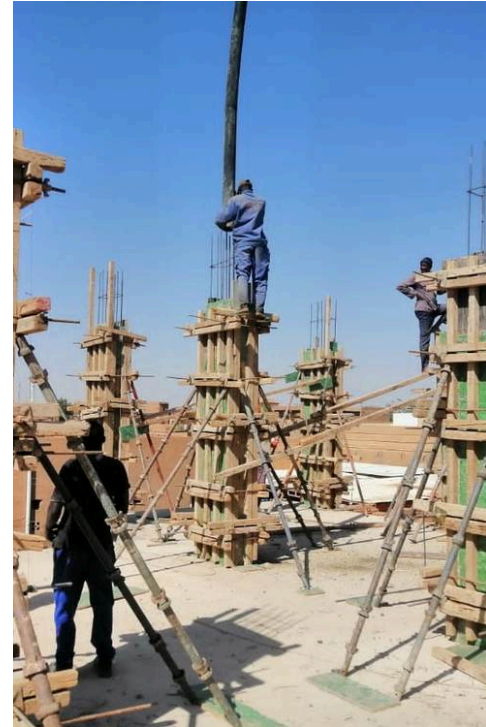

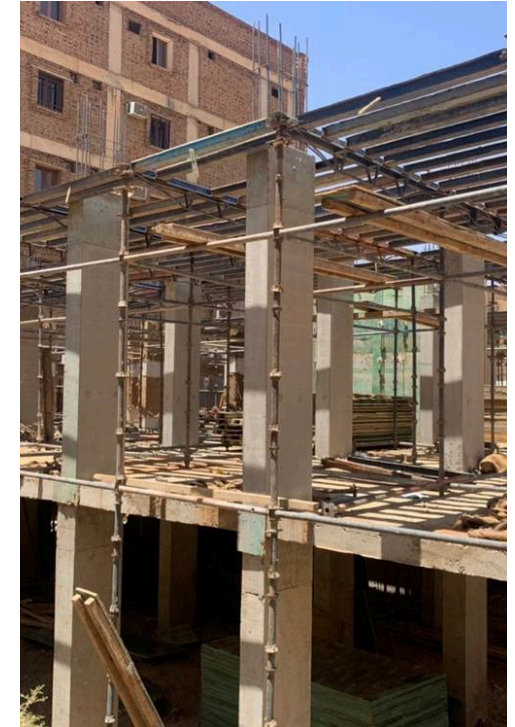

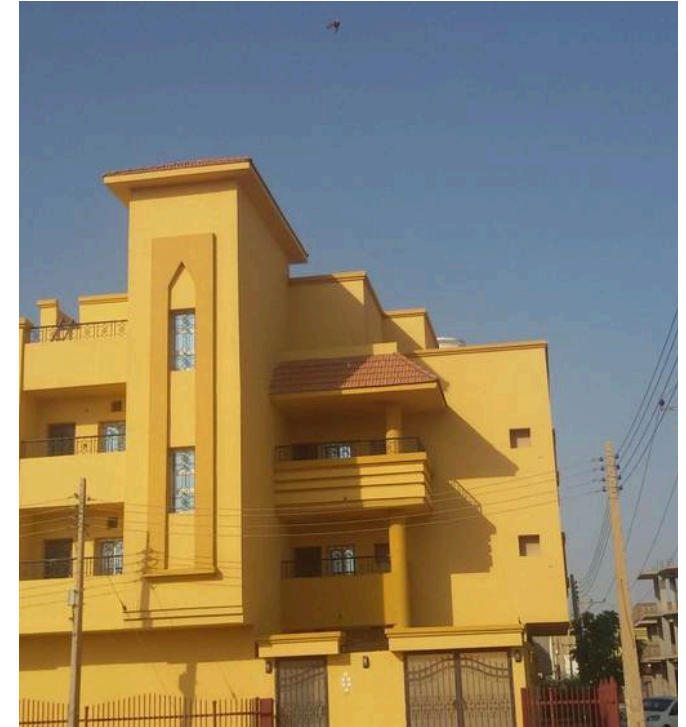
